For the November concert, he will lead **Song of the Angels Flute Orchestra** in **Fantasy on Coventry Carol** by Catherine McMichael, John Williams' **Fantasy Medley**, **Silver Winds in the Night** arranged by Jackson Berkey (Manheim Steamroller,) Colin Touchin's Heroics, The Winter's Passed by Wayne Barlow and **The Nutcracker Suite** by Peter Ilyich Tchaikovsky including the **Miniature Overture**, **March**, **Danse of the Sugar Plum Fairy**, **Arab Danse**, **Danse of the Mirlitons** and **Chinese Danse**.

The Winter's Passed, written by Wayne Barlow "for Francine Ross Pancost," the Principal Alto Flute for SOA Flute Orchestra. Francine will perform as Alto Flute soloist in a special arrangement of The Winter's Passed by her husband, Dr. Raymond Pancost. She earned her Bachelor's degree from the Eastman School of Music, studying with Joseph Mariano, and a Masters from U.S.C. Francine is also currently Director/Conductor of the Jewel City Flute Choir. She has just begun a music publication company "SilverWinds" including 3 of her arrangements; Francine continues to arrange new pieces for flute ensembles. Mrs. Pancost maintains an active teaching studio.

Francine has been heard live on KUSC, KFAC radio and many recordings. She has performed with the Santa Barbara Symphony, Long Beach Symphony, Chuck Mangione, Foothill Artists Trio and Five Winds Quintet including performing for the Da Camera Society, South Bay Chamber Music Series and LACMA. Francine performed in the Aspen Music Festival and Chamber Orchestras and has filmed for Bravo TV.
